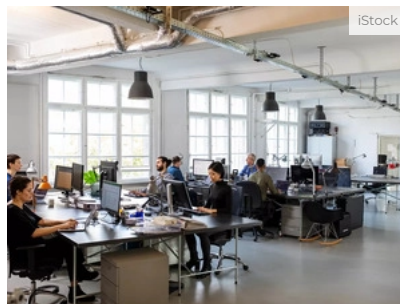


Co-working firm Synq.Work to focus on expansion, plans to enter tier 2 cities
